Criminal Procedure Code, 1973, Section 438 - Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 Sections 21, 61 and 85 Allegedly that two accused persons fled away on their motorcycle by throwing 100 grams of Heroin on seeing police party - Anticipatory bail application - Petitioner had no previous criminal record - Neither the petitioner was apprehended at the spot nor any recovery effected from him - Custodial interrogation of petitioner is no longer required - Bail granted.

JUDGMENT

Mr. Jaswant Singh, J. (Oral) - Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner-Manpreet Singh @ Manaa in case FIR No. 231 dated 10.12.2015, under Sections 21/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act,1985, registered with Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

- 2. As per the allegations, two accused persons fled away on their motorcycle by throwing 100 grams of Heroin on seeing the police party.
- 3. It was contended that petitioner is a student of B.A.1st Year with no previous criminal record and falsely implicated due to political rivalry. It was also submitted that neither the petitioner was apprehended at the spot nor any recovery effected from him.
- 4. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.
- 5. Learned State Counsel, assisted by A.S.I. Paramjeet Singh, concedes the aforesaid submission. In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 04.02.2016, is made absolute. Disposed of.
